Encore Presentation 'Into Africa'

Thursday, March the 23rd, at 7pm

Linda Gregory will give an Encore presentation of her "into Africa" presentation from the last Membership Meeting.

When Linda Gregory mentioned to Camera Club friend, Patty Ferguson, that her dream was to travel to Africa, Patty said, "I'll go." They selected an Overseas Adventure Travel trip, Ultimate Africa, based on the positive feedback other members had provided. The goal was to see the animals in the wild, but the birds and cultural experiences were equally as rewarding. They visited locations in South Africa, Botswana, Zambia, and Zimbabwe. They started the trip with a Kruger pre-trip where they saw the big five in four days. It only got better from there. Come and see their photographs and have an opportunity to ask them questions about their trip.



April Speaker - Ted Fleming

April 20, 1:30-3pm

An ecologist by training and a long-time amateur photographer, Mr. Fleming spent most of his career as a Professor of Biology at the University of Miami. His research specialty is tropical plant-animal interactions, particularly pollination and seed dispersal mutualisms. He traveled extensively in the tropics for research, always with a camera in tow. Mr. Fleming feels that his photography has really blossomed in the digital age. "I'm particularly interested in 'painterly' images and usually convert my favorite photos into digital paintings under the influence of artists such as Monet, Renoir, Van Gogh, Edward Hopper, Georgia O'Keefe, and Maynard Dixon". He has rather eclectic tastes in his subjects but has not done much landscape photography. Given his background as a biologist, he particularly enjoys photographing wildlife, but also likes to photograph people 'doing interesting things.

As an artist, he is often drawn to images that are visually complex (reflecting his lifelong interest in biological diversity) and colorful. He also seeks images that are elegant in their composition or graphic elements. One of his current techniques involves creating photo montages as a way of emphasizing the place of wildlife and people in their natural environment.

A former president of Club Camera Tucson and has photographic images that have appeared in a variety of local galleries and exhibitions, including Tohono Chul, Tubac Center of the Arts, Dove Mountain Gallery, Ventana Medical Services, and Toscana Gallery. Two of his fine art books ('Art in the Park' and 'Bisbee') are available in local bookstores.
